### **Week of February 20th-23rd**

Staff from ESDH will visit each feeder school (GBJH & OPA). Students will learn about the O2 program & how to apply. ESDH French Immersion teachers will also come and speak to the feeder school grade nine French Immersion classes about the continuation of the program opportunities at high school level.

### **Week of February 26th-March 1st**

The ESDH school counselor will visit each feeder school and meet with all of our future 10s to review the courses available to choose from for their first year in high school. Students will receive both a course selection booklet and a course selection sheet after their session to complete at home with their family. There is also a section that allows them to plan out courses for consideration in their grade 11 and grade 12 year.
